Pariyaram, Kannur on 13.04.2015

ORDER

Government have entered into an agreement with Pariyaram Medical  
College, Pariyaram, Kannur for PG Medical Admission 2015-16 with the  
following terms and conditions:

1. 50% of total PG Medical (MS/MD/Diploma) seats sanctioned in the  
College will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by  
the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit  
and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.
2. The Commissioner of Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of  
the students to be admitted in the college by the Educational Agency  
and the Educational Agency concerned shall admit the students  
specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific  
instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college  
for admission, the amount of fees to be paid, and the records to be  
submitted at the time of admission. The Educational Agency shall  
admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified  
by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations. The Commissioner of  
Entrance Examinations shall furnish such list on or before  
5PM, 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2015 or such other date as mutually agreed upon by the  
parties. The Managements concerned shall accept and admit the  
students accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not  
later than 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2015. The Management concerned shall be entitled  
to fill those seats remaining unfilled by Government after the cut off  
date for admission to Government merit quota seats for 2015-16 subject

to the condition that the forfeited seats will not be compensated during next academic year.

3. If any student is not admitted by the Educational Agency concerned for specific defects for reasons what so ever, it shall intimate the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures.
4. The Educational Agency concerned agrees to collect annual tuition fees for those 50% merit quota students during the entire course period at the rate specified below.

Post Graduate Degree (Clinical)	Rs. 6,90,000
Post Graduate Degree (Non-Clinical)	Rs. 2,40,000
Post Graduate Diploma (Clinical)	Rs. 4,50,000

Signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the Management/College for all students.

5. The annual tuition fee fixed shall be inclusive of all amounts collected as in the case of similarly admitted students in Self Financing Colleges. However, the Educational Agency concerned can also collect the proportionate share of fee payable to the University and other statutory bodies in relation to the course of study being undergone by each student. The Educational Agency concerned shall not collect any amount from any student so admitted, other than those specified above.
6. 50% of the total seats shall be Management quota seats (except NRI quota) to be filled by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit from the list of students who have qualified themselves in Kerala State Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination 2015. In the event of sufficient number of qualified candidates under Kerala State Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination 2015, who have applied for Management quota seats in the institution concerned are not available, the Managements can admit students on the basis of any P.G. Medical Entrance Examination 2015 conducted at the National level as per MCI norms. Out of the 50%, the Managements are entitled to fill up



15% of seats by the eligible students who are children/dependants of Non-Resident Indians, as per the conditions stipulated in GO(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013 and further orders in this regard if any, issued by Government from time to time. All the students under NRI quota are admitted on the basis of Entrance Test conducted by Kerala Admission Supervisory/Fee Regulatory Committee for Professional Colleges in this regard.

7. In view of the representation of the Educational Agency with regard to the expenses incurred for establishing and administering and for further developing infrastructure and facilities in the College and for payment of stipend at Government rates to PG students as stipulated by the Medical Council of India, the Educational Agency shall be entitled to collect annual fee for the 50% Management quota students except NRI quota, during the entire course period as specified below:

Post Graduate Degree (Clinical)	-	Rs.15,00,000/- ✗
Post Graduation Degree (Non-Clinical)	-	Rs. 4,80,000/- ✓
Post Graduate Diploma (Clinical)	-	Rs.10,50,000/- ✗

The Students under 50% Management Quota including NRI Quota, will have to submit a bank guarantee at the time of admission for the annual tuition fee for the entire course period.

8. All the students admitted in the Self Financing College will execute a bond to the effect that they will serve the Institution for a period of One year as Senior Resident/Tutor/Demonstrator at the rate fixed by the Government in Government Medical Colleges after successful completion of Post Graduation course.
9. The seat sharing between the Educational Agency and Government shall be as per the methodology fixed as per GO(Rt)No.2138/2011/H&FWD dated 02.06.2011.
10. The Educational Agency undertakes that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the college. It shall be the liability of the Educational Agency to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any

matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement.
