PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO M.PHARM COURSES 2018 (MANAGEMENT and NRI QUOTA)

Introduction

The Academy of Medical Sciences (ACME), Pariyaram, Kannur District, established on 17-11-1993. The main objective of the society is to organize and conduct graduate and post graduate courses, training in modern medicines, pharmacy, nursing and to provide research facilities for carrying on research in all systems and disciplines of medical and surgical knowledge keeping in view the socio medical and socio economical needs of the state of Kerala and to provide, encourage, initiate or promote facilities for research improvement or development of new methods or equipments of diagnosis, understanding, prevention and treatment of diseases.

Accordingly the Academy offered medical, dental, pharmaceutical, nursing and paramedical courses and imparted respective quality education in Medical science since 1995, Dental science since 2004, Pharmaceutical sciences since 2003, Nursing sciences since 2002 and Paramedical sciences since 2006.

This prospectus for admission to Pharmacy courses 2018 at Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences which is subject to the approval by the Admission Supervisory Committee appointed by Govt. of Kerala is published here with. Any change in the prospectus, if made by the Admission Supervisory Committee shall be

published in the website of the institution immediately after its receipt and included in the prospects. The prospectus contains general information, rules and regulations relating to admission under management open quota 2018 and admission under Non Resident Indians (NRI) quota 2018 of Pharmacy courses.

Pharmacy is that branch of science and techniques of preparing and dispensing drugs. It is a health profession that links health sciences with chemical sciences. It further associates with health care service which aims at ensuring safe and effective use of pharmaceutical drugs. The profession of Pharmacy has transformed in to a hub for the 'Global health care' and evolved as a multidisciplinary and multifaceted curriculum. This new decade is thus, bound to have an ever growing demand of pharmacy professionals not only in India, but also worldwide.

Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences is one of the constituent institution under Academy of Medical Sciences established in the year 2003. The college is committed to quality education and dissemination of knowledge in Pharmaceutical sciences, for better health care and service to the society. The institution is offering courses like B Pharm, M Pharm and Pharm D. All the courses offered are approved by competent authorities. The college is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) vide F.No South-West/1-2812172119/2016/EOA Dated 5-4-16, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) vide their order nos.32-283/2014-PCI/58866-68 dated 05/3/15(B Pharm), 50-283/2014-PCI/20882-84 dated 17/7/14 and Government of Kerala. The Institution is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences.

Master of Pharmacy (M Pharm)

M Pharm. is a post graduate course after B Pharm. The duration of the course is two years. We are having the Post Graduate Programme in the following Subjects

I M Pharm -Pharmaceutics

Pharmaceutics is the discipline of pharmacy that deals with the process of turning a new chemical entity (NCE) into a medication to be used safely and effectively by patients. It is also called the science of dosage form design. Department of pharmaceutics provides training and expertise in drug formulation, delivery and inter relationships between in vitro and in vivo drug disposition to students as a prerequisite qualification for a career in the pharmaceutical industry or as an academic scientist.

II MPharm -Pharmacology

Pharmacology is the branch of medicine and biology concerned with the study of drug action, where a drug can be broadly defined as any man-made, natural, or endogenous (within the body) molecule which exerts a biochemical and/or physiological effect on the cell, tissue, organ, or organism. More specifically, it is the study of the interactions that occur between living organisms and chemicals that affect normal or abnormal biochemical function.

III M Pharm -Pharmacognosy and Photochemistry

Pharmacognosy represents a highly interdisciplinary science, which is one among the four major areas of pharmaceutical education. Pharmacognosy is a multi disciplinary subject that comprises parts of Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology and Pharmaceutical chemistry. Pharmacognosy is the study of medicines derived from natural sources. The American Society of Pharmacognosy defines pharmacognosy as the study of crude drugs.

3. Career Opportunities

India has vast and growing pharmaceutical industries, educational institutions, research organizations and hospitals. Pharmacy has large scope of career opportunities both by way of jobs as well as in terms of starting own business. A career in pharmacy, unfolds a vista full of opportunities leading to golden future for a young aspirant. The job opportunities, working conditions, job satisfaction and monetary benefits are also equally good.

4. Seats and Quotas

35% seats of Management quota and 15% NRI quota are filled by the management

5. Eligibility criteria for Admission to the Courses:

Indian citizens only are eligible for admission to Pharmacy courses. Persons of Indian origin (PIO) and overseas citizens of India (OCI) will also be treated at par with Indian citizens for the limited purpose of admission.

M Pharm

Candidates who have passed B Pharm. degree examination of Kerala University of Health Sciences or an examination equivalent thereto of any other university recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences with not less than a total of 55% marks for the B Pharm degree examination are eligible for admission to M Pharm degree course. The candidate should have undergone B Pharm degree course in an institution approved by AICTE and the PCI. No candidate shall be permitted to do post graduate course in more than one specialty simultaneously.

6. Method of Selection

Management and NRI Quota

Selection will be made based on the merit. Merit will be decided on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations.

NRI quota

Those who apply under NRI quota should satisfy all the conditions stipulated in GO (MS) NO.34/2013/H & FWD dated 05-02-2013 and GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dated 22-05-2013 and GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06-08-2014 of the Govt. of Kerala regarding NRI status. NRI applicant is he/she who depends upon his/her father /mother/brothers and sisters(inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/husband/wife/brother/half brother/half sister/Adopted father/ Adopted mother working abroad. Selection will be made based on the merit. Merit will be decided on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations.

Applicants seeking admission under NRI quota should produce the following certificates/ documents apart from other certificates/documents required for management open quota applicants.

1. Copy of Passport and Viza attested by the respective Indian Embassy/ Consulate.
2. If the Viza is not stamped, employment certificate duly attested by the respective Indian Embassy/ Consulate.
3. Sponsorship certificate.
4. Relationship Certificate.

7. Fees

Fees for Management open quota and NRI quota will be as fixed by the Govt. subject to approval by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Fee Regulatory Committee. The same has not been finalised so far. Fees consented/ agreed at the time of admission shall be paid within the stipulated time every year.

a) Liquidated damages

If any candidate discontinues after closing of admission to join other courses/colleges or for other purposes, he/she is liable to pay liquidated damages equal to that of the total fees for the entire course. Liquidated damages shall be levied irrespective of annual income of the family. Legal action under Revenue Recovery Act shall be taken to recover the damages in case of failure to remit the liquidated damages. The applicant and his/her parent shall execute a bond in stamp paper, to the effect that they agree to pay liquidated damages.

b) Special fees

Special fees applicable shall be paid at the time of admission itself. Students getting admission will be insured in group against illness, accident etc and annual premium thereon will be collected at the time of admission and also every year.

5. How to apply

Application form can be downloaded from the Academy website www.mcpariyaram.com from 13-07-2018. The cost of application form for M Pharm Management quota is Rs.1000/- and Rs. 1000/- for NRI quota . If you apply for both Management & NRI seats you should tick in all options and pay application fee Rs.2000/- (1000+1000). DD in favour of '**The Principal, Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur 670503**'. The signed hard copy of the application along with DD, and relevant documents should reach '**The Principal, Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pariyaram Medical College P.O 670503, Kannur District**' on or before 26rd July 2018. The online application without hardcopy, DD for required fee and other documents will be rejected promptly, without further notice.

Following certificates/documents shall be enclosed along with the application form for M Pharm Course.

1. True copy of the S.S.L.C book or any relevant records to prove date of birth and age
2. Certificates to prove nativity.
3. Certificates in support of claim for Communal Reservation, in the prescribed format. Inter- Caste marriage certificate in prescribed format, if applicable.
4. Attested copy of Certificate of the Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities.
5. Copy of the "Admit Card of GPAT examination" (Except service candidates)
6. Certificate in support of Academic qualification, Service, declaration of probation and other documents (for service candidates).
7. Copy of the State Pharmacy Council Registration

Other essential certificates/documents to be produced at the time of counseling/selection and admission:

Following are the essential certificates/ documents that are to be produced at the time of counseling/selection in addition to those mentioned above

1. Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended and Conduct Certificate.
2. Certificate of recognition and equivalency in the State of Kerala and Migration Certificate.
3. Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format.
4. Vaccination certificate against hepatitis, MMR and chickenpox
5. Joint undertaking as per the provisions of anti-ragging verdict by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The applicants shall produce the originals of attested copies of certificates/ documents mentioned above at the time of counseling/selection. Belated, incomplete or defective applications will be summarily rejected.

9. Counseling /Interview/ Selection and Admission

Counseling/Interview will be held at the college for selection and admission of students to the course. The selected candidate may join the course on the date mentioned with required fee as the quota may be and submit all essential testimonials/documents. Failure in payment of required fees within the time limit mentioned above will result in cancellation of admission. Part payment of fees will not be accepted. The date of counseling will be intimated by e-mail to the short listed candidates as well as published in the institutional website. Important dates that are to be borne in mind are furnished.

10. Verification of documents

The Principal shall be personally responsible for verification and satisfaction of the correctness of the records produced by the candidates at the time of admission.

11. Residential accommodation

Available accommodation will be provided to students subject to the terms and conditions of the institution. Preference will be given to those who hail from outside the home district.

12. Sports activities

Students may actively participate in the sports and games activities of the college as well as of the University.

13. Parent Teachers Association (PTA)

The institution has an active Parent Teachers Association to which the parents of the beginners may also extent their considerable contribution. Parents should feel free to

interact with the teachers quite frequently so as to enable the formers 'wards to perform well in their studies.

14. Redressal of grievances

Grievances/ complaints if any regarding selection/admission may be brought to the notice of the Principal of the College/ Director of the Society/Academy for taking remedial measures promptly.

15. Discipline

Selected and admitted students should obey the rules and regulations of the institution strictly. Failure to observe absolute discipline will attract stringent disciplinary action. 80% attendance is compulsory in each academic year for both theory and practical separately. Students should wear prescribed uniform during college hours. They are expected to wear respectable dresses. Use of mobile phone is prohibited at nearby premises of the hospital, class rooms, lecture halls, practical class locations, libraries etc. Smoking, consumption of alcohol and use of psycho tropic substances are totally prohibited. The students should pay adequate attention in neatness and cleanliness and sincerely cooperate with the authorities in maintaining a healthy environment in the campus.

16. Malpractices

Malpractices of any sort for securing admission are nothing but illegal. If a candidate is found to have indulged in malpractices at any time, his admission will be forfeited followed by initiation of criminal proceedings against him.

17. Ragging

As per Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998, ragging is a criminal offence. Ragging means doing of any act by disorderly conduct against a student of an educational institution, which causes or likely to cause physical or physiological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do. Whoever commits, takes part in or abets, aids, or protects a student indulged in ragging within or outside the campus shall be liable for deterrent disciplinary proceedings coupled with criminal action. The institution has to abide by the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court of India dated 16th May 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 200, SLP (C) No. 24296-99/2004 and WP (CrI) No. 173/2006 & SLP(C) No. 14356/2005. Every student and his parent/ guardian have to submit a joint undertaking at the time of admission, which is mandatory for getting admission. The

Principal shall take all the preventive and anti-ragging measures and ensure strict enforcement of the law against ragging.

18. General

All concerned should read this prospectus carefully and comply with the instructions scrupulously. Disputes pertaining to the examination, selection and admission, if any, shall fall within the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala. Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the Principal in consultation with the Management of the Academy and his decision will be final.
